- Visual Artists: Include five (5) images of current work formatted for PC at 72 dpi, no larger than 1000x1000 pixels. For time based work, please send up to five (5) minutes on a DVD. Be sure to label the CD or DVD with your name and title of work(s).
- Writers: Include a writing sample (up to 10 pages). You may submit finished pieces, or works-in-progress. Do not send a complete book.
- Composers: Send one (1) sets of the following: score sheets, and a corresponding CD of the work labeled with your name and title. Do not send more than ten (10) minutes.
- Include an image inventory sheet (where applicable) with corresponding numbers, title, date, medium and dimensions.
- Include contact information for three (3) professional references. List his/her name, title, address, phone, email.
- If I am NOT awarded a scholarship: I will be able to attend

- Include SASE (appropriate size and postage) if you would like your application materials returned to you.

SCHOLARSHIP DEPOSIT: If you are awarded a scholarship, you will be asked to submit a \$300 deposit to accept it and reserve your space. The deposit can be applied to your balance when due (60 days prior to the start of your workshop) or it will be refunded upon your arrival at Spiro Arts.

SCHOLARSHIP CANCELLATION POLICY: If you need to cancel your workshop and/or housing and we are given the required 30 days' notice, we will refund your deposits less the \$45 registration fee, \$100 cancellation fee (per workshop) and the \$50 housing cancellation fee (per week of housing reserved). If you cancel within 30 days of the start of your workshop, no refund will be issued, i.e., you will forfeit your \$300 deposit and any additional monies paid. If we cancel a workshop, you will have the option of either a full refund or transferring to another workshop, space permitting.
